Dear :

This is to inform you that the funds of three three hundred thousand United States dollars transferred from your account has failed. Having exceeded the 5 day pending period, the funds have now been returned back to your account.

Your account is still in dormant status and requires activation. Due to the fact that this is an inherited account, we may be compelled by law to close down the account by 19-02-2014, if the account has not been activated. This account will then be handed over to the Authorities to verify the inheritance.

This is because the time to activate the account has exceeded the normal 14 days activation period and this is deemed to mean that there are perhaps disputes regarding the account and in such cases, we are obliged by law to hand the account over to the authorities for settlement.
